- COVID-19 restrictions has suspended branch technical meetings and activities;
- 2019 opening balance was £6,023.48 closing at £5,521.72;
- 2020 opening balance was £5,521.72 closing at £11,333.02;
- 2020 Grant Application from HQ was reduced to £5,961.00 due to COVID-19;
- 2020 Expenditure £149.70 towards committee expenses and delayed awards payment;
- 2021 opening balance was £11,333.02 with funding from HQ at £4,017.00 and £2,832.00 credit from the Birmingham Chamber of Commerce;
- 2021 branch account balance at £16,530.06;
